**JO BANANAS DUKE STREET WHITEHAVEN APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF PREMISES  
LICENSE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003**

With regards to the above application and following consultation with the applicant police would like to see the following conditions attached to the license.

1. Images recorded by CCTV shall be retained in unedited form for a period of not less than 28 days.
2. The images shall be provided to the relevant authority upon reasonable request or otherwise within seven days.
3. Door supervisors shall be provided at the premises door to such a number that the management of the premises consider are sufficient to control the entry of persons to the premises and for the keeping of order in the premises when they are used for licensable activity. Door supervisors will be SIA registered. Door supervisors to be present at the establishment until the premises has emptied.
4. There will be an expectation from SIA staff and stewards that should they witness any crime and disorder that they will assist with the detection of crime by providing a statement of evidence to the police.

In addition to the above new conditions, the applicant has also agreed to transfer all existing conditions from the current licence to the varied licence. In exception of -

There is no longer a need to have SIA registered door staff dressed in high visibility clothing. They will be identified by their identification badge worn on the arm.

The applicant wishes to provide alcohol in glass wear in daytime hours and up until 22.00 hours in the evening, beyond this point drinks of all description will be served in plastic vessels. The applicant has agreed that should there be a large event such as a world cup, boxing or anything that is going to attract increased numbers then plastic vessels to be provided throughout.

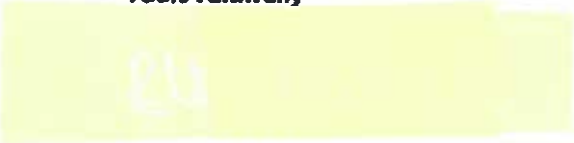
